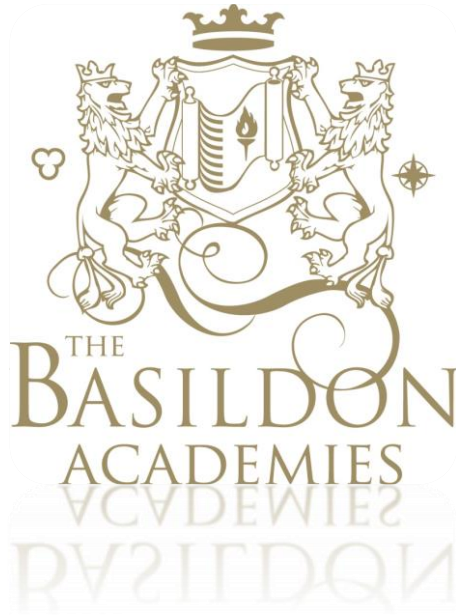

Summer School Programme August 2021

This report will outline spend of the School Summer Holiday Programme August 2021, in line with: <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/summer-schools-programme/summer-schools-guidance#funding>

The Department of Education allocated funding to schools in order to run Summer Holiday (School) programmes over the August break 2021 in light of the impacts of the Covid 19 pandemic.

The Basildon Academies ran 2 programmes in line with this ambition, 1 at the Lower Academy to support Year 6 into 7 transition and 1 at the Upper Academy to support Year 10 into 11 transition. The Lower Academy provision ran over 2 weeks, with students selecting a week to attend. The Upper Academy provision ran over 1 week leading into the school return for students.

In line with DfE Guidance, a range of activities were delivered to support students in both academic and enrichment activities.

At the Lower Academy, these included:

- Daily English & Maths session
- Drama & Dance
- Sports
- Gardening
- Art & Crafts
- History
- Sign Language
- Computer Science
- Respect & Wellbeing
- Social Skills
- External Providers: Teambuilding

Every day began with a collective session to discuss aims of the day and ended with a celebration event, including rewards for those had shown growth and effort each day.

At the Upper Academy, activities included:

- English
- Maths
- Science
- Hums
- Sports
