

Enrichment rotation: Project

Enrichment aim: Students will complete a project based around one of the student values. After a brief introduction of all the values, the student will choose what value/topic they want to research. The student will then be given the opportunity of using the computer room to carry their research and preparation work. The teacher will be a facilitator to assist them to complete their research/preparation work. They will produce a 1 A4 page information sheet about their project and then present a short 2-minute spoken presentation about their project. Completion of the project will go towards their unifrog profile and they will also receive a BA certificate of completion.
