Preparing for Year 10: Transition Weeks at the Upper Academy

Highlights include:

- Taster lessons at the Upper Academy every Tuesday and Thursday.

Monday:	Accomplishment (Noun) kubudirira in Shona Definition: Something that has been achieved successfully. Example: Recognition of accomplishments can inspire others to pursue their goals with determination.		
Tuesday:	Proficiency (Noun) thông thạo in Vietnamese Definition: A high degree of competence or skill. Example: Mastering new skills is a sign of proficiency and contributes to overall achievement.		
Wednesday:	Excellence (Noun) доброта in Bulgarian Definition: The quality of being outstanding or extremely good. Example: Striving for excellence is essential for personal and professional achievement.		
Thursday:	Triumph (Noun) triumphe in Estonian Definition: A great victory or success. Example: The team's triumph in the championship was celebrated by the entire community.		
Friday:	Fulfilment (Noun) पूरा गर्ने in Nepali Definition: The achievement of something desired, promised, or predicted. Example: Completing the marathon gave him a sense of fulfilment after months of training.

To report a student absence please visit the Contact Us page via the Basildon Lower Academy website and select the option for Attendance.

- Parents/carers must contact the school by 8.30am each day their child is absent.
- If no reason has been received for a child's absence, the Academy will initiate first day calling.
- Parent/carers may be asked for medical evidence to support absences after 3 days or reoccurring absence patterns.
- Wherever possible, parents/carers should make appointments outside of school hours. If this is unavoidable students should attend school before and after the appointment.
